Purpose

The Rural Municipality of Fisher recognizes that the cutting of hay on road allowances enhances the appearance and level of safety for the motoring public.

Scope

This policy applies to all improved road allowances in the Rural Municipality of Fisher that are used for baling hay.

Definitions

Landowner's Adjacent Land means an individual's land which is owned or leased from the crown.

Road Allowance Use for Hay Policy

The Rural Municipality of Fisher allows the cutting of hay on road allowances.

Guidelines

1. The party cutting hay is the adjacent landowner, or has received the permission of the adjacent landowner, or the adjacent landowner has no interest in the hay.
2. Hay shall not be permitted to be left on any road surface at any time.
3. All bales must be 15 feet from any road surface.
4. Bales must be removed from road allowance no later than 14 days following the baling.
5. The right-of-way must be left in a neat condition by the person salvaging the hay.
6. The municipality has the right to seize any uncollected bales and dispose of same at its discretion.
7. The Municipality assumes no liability for labourers, machinery, or bales relating to the salvage of hay.
8. The Council reserves the privilege and right for any of its members, employees, and/or agents, to enter upon road allowance and right-of-way for the maintenance and/or reconstruction of roadway or for other purposes as may be deemed necessary, and at no compensation or reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay.
