FIRE PERMITS, NO BURNING WITHOUT ONE

Summer is upon us, and with it comes the potential for dry conditions. This raises the risk of wildfires significantly.

Year round, if you're going to burn, you must have a burn permit. They are free and can be applied for at the RM of Fisher office.

Permits allow us to keep Forestry officials, and our own Fire Department informed of potential danger, so they can be prepared and ready to act quickly in the unfortunate event of a fire getting out ot control.

Serious fines will also be imposed to those who burn without a permit. For more information, please contact the RM office at 204-372-6393.

Keep a safe distance from other vehicles, and slow down when changing directions, like lane changes, or swerving for wildlife. Drive in visible tracks, they will give you more stability. Stopping is more difficult at high speeds, allow for time to stop safely.
