OVERLAND FLOODING SLOWS

Future Weather Remains Important Factor

The Rural Municipality of Fisher continues to respond to flooding.

Council declared a State of Local Emergency on April 21, 2026.

The provincial Hydrologic Forecast Centre reports the flow of the Fisher River is going down. Water levels are expected to remain below community flood protection levels.

Overland flooding in the RM has not increased in the last 48 hours.

The RM will be advocating for a Disaster Financial Assistance Program to help cover costs incurred during this flood and the rebuilding of critical infrastructure after the province declined requests for immediate financial aid.

- To date, about 45 homes and businesses throughout the municipality have been impacted by the spring melt and flooding.
- Overland flooding has impacted several roads in the municipality. Drivers are requested to stay away from work areas for everyone's safety. Please do not attempt to check on the situation.
- There are family emergency preparedness guides available for pickup in the municipal office.
- The RCMP reminds people to stay away from waterways.

Residents with questions requiring flood preparation should contact their ward Councillor or municipal office.
