

Lakeshore School Division Update

Thank you for the opportunity to share information about our division and the schools in the Fisher Branch and surrounding area. We hope to keep you informed with the following information in regard to four main areas of School Division funding.

2024 School Budget

School funding is crucial to supporting our educational programs. After a four-year freeze on school tax increase, we have chosen to increase school taxes this year by 3%. This increase will fall in line with the projected inflation for the upcoming year.

There will be a 50% rebate on all school taxes for this year. In 2025 you will find this percentage rate rebate replaced by a \$1500 flat rate, and the farm property rebate will remain at 50%. Houses below a \$285,000 assessed value will effectively no longer pay school property tax.

Staffing

In the upcoming school year, we are fortunate to be able to add some additional teacher time. We are experiencing a growth in the student enrolment at Fisher Branch Early Years so this will helpful our existing staff and the students.

We will be adding some additional time to our student services budget. This will enable more time for staff to support those students who require some extra time and/or instruction with their learning.

Programming

Our early years programming is for kindergarten to grade 4 and students who attend at the Early Years School. At the Fisher Branch Collegiate, we have students from Grade 5 through 12. Their academic program is divided into two areas – Middle Years (grade 5-8) and Senior High (Grade 9-12). In addition to academic programming the school offers sports programs and we are happy that next year the province has added more financial support for nutritional programs. This will support and expand the existing breakfast programming at the schools and help make sure that all learners area ready to learn throughout the day.

Strategic Plan

Our Board has developed two focuses in our strategic plan. These include career/future readiness and well-being. Using a provincial grant and divisional funding we are developing a career playbook to support students in making decisions about their future. We are excited to see this implemented in the coming months and year, and the positive impact that this will have on our communities.

TO FLUSH OR NOT TO FLUSH? 🖢

Many items we use on a daily basis cannot go down our toilets or drains. Several products, even those labelled "flushable" or "biodegradable" do not dissolve and putting them down the toilet or drain can cause:

- *I* Damage or blockages to your home plumbing, which could lead to basement flooding.
- If Damage to the Local Urban District sewer pipes located under the streets, which could lead to basement flooding.
- P Harm to the environment and aquatic habitat in lakes, local streams and rivers.

To help keep the entire sewage system working well and prevent sewer blockages and/or sewer service line blockages that can result in basement flooding, it's important to practice only flushung the 3 "P"s when flushing your toilet.
